The dust jacket of a book is the detachable outer cover, usually made of paper and printed with text and illustrations. This outer cover has folded flaps that hold it to the front and back book covers. Often the back panel or flaps are printed with biographical information about the author, a summary of the book from the publisher or critical praise from celebrities or authorities in the book's subject area. In addition to its promotional role, the dust jacket protects the book covers from damage.

This is expressed as pages-per-inch. A typical book paper is 400 pages per inch. This paper would create a spine width of 1.0" for a 400 page book. But a dust jacket needs to take into account the thickness of the boards that make up the case, and the rounded corners of the case. Because the cases of hardcover books extend past the edges of the paper, a 6" x 9" book will need a jacket that's approximately 9.25" high. Why do I say approximately?

To make sure that the dimensions of your jacket are perfect, you'll need to first measure the size of your book's face from bottom to top to find its length then spine to edge to find its width. Cut a strip of paper six inches longer than the height and fold it over each side, trimming until you are happy with the size. Measure this new length.

Find an 11 x 17 inch piece of paper to make a book dust jacket. For most books, this paper size is adequate. Center your book in the middle of paper. Locate the spine's edges.

Dust jackets, or book jackets, were originally used to protect the hardcover case of casebound books. Today, they are an art form all their own. Spread out the dust jacket on the protective covering to measure how much covering you will need. Using the ruler to draw a straight line, mark the cutting edge. Cut the protective cover. Pull the paper liner of the protective cover away from the clear cover. Insert the dust jacket between the paper and clear cover.

Most printed books, use uncoated paper stocks for the inside pages of the book, and a coated cover stock for the book cover. Uncoated stocks come in different finishes and paper weights. Uncoated paper comes in two different finishes, either a vellum or smooth finish.

The spine of dust jackets, paper covers, or case-wraps is usually printed with the author's last name, the title of the book, and a way to identify the publisher. This might take the form of the publisher's initials, a shortened version of the publisher's name, or the use of the publisher's logo.

When your edits are finished, cut two strips of lined paper, about 4 inches wide and as long as the book jacket will be. Publish the final draft by writing out your summary on one of the strips (the front flap), and continuing onto the other (the back flap).

Step 1, Grab some brown paper, butcher paper, or a brown paper bag. All of these types of paper can make an excellent book cover. This type of cover can be left as is, or made fancier with stamping, painting or decoupageing.
